VULNERABLE ADULTS PROTECTION POLICY

WE:

recognise that everyone has different levels of vulnerability and that each of us may be regarded as vulnerable at some time in our lives

commit ourselves to the safeguarding of people who may be vulnerable, ensuring their well-being while attending our performances or rehearsals

commit ourselves to promoting safe practice by those in positions of trust.

commit ourselves to promoting the inclusion and empowerment of people who may be vulnerable.

WE WILL:

as members of Sprowston Parish Players, commit ourselves to respectful care for all adults to whom we come into contact with

endeavour to prevent the abuse (of any kind) of vulnerable people and to report any such abuse that we discover or suspect

undertake to exercise proper care in the appointment and selection of those who will work with people who may be vulnerable

Each person who works with vulnerable people will agree to abide by the guidelines.

WHEN THERE ARE CONCERNS about the welfare of any adult, *all adult members* in our organisation are expected to share those concerns with **the Chairman or Secretary of the group.**

He/she is responsible for:

Monitoring and recording concerns

Reporting back to the Committee

Liaison with other agencies

CONFIDENTIALITY:

Major concerns about the behaviour of adult(s) in the organisation, will be referred without delay to the above officers, who will contact Social Care Services or the Police, as appropriate.
